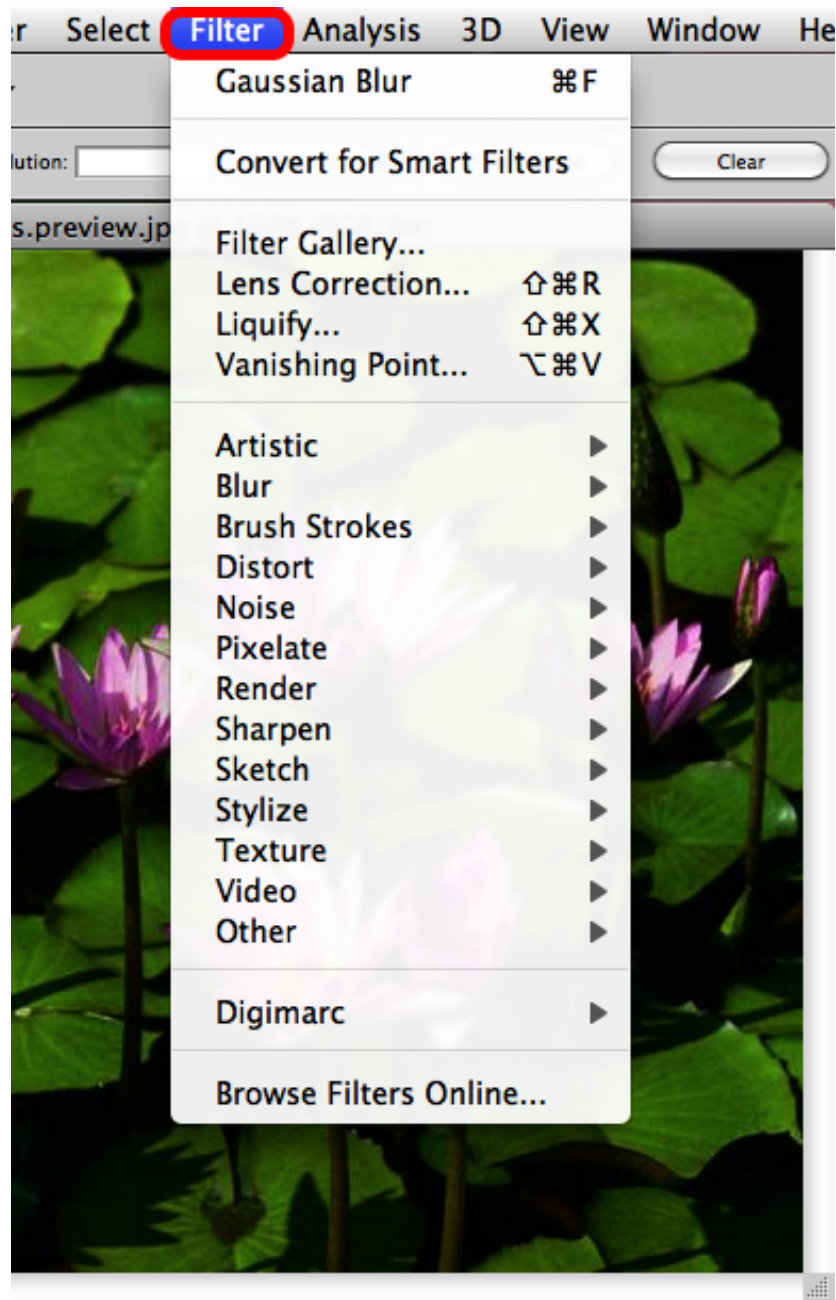

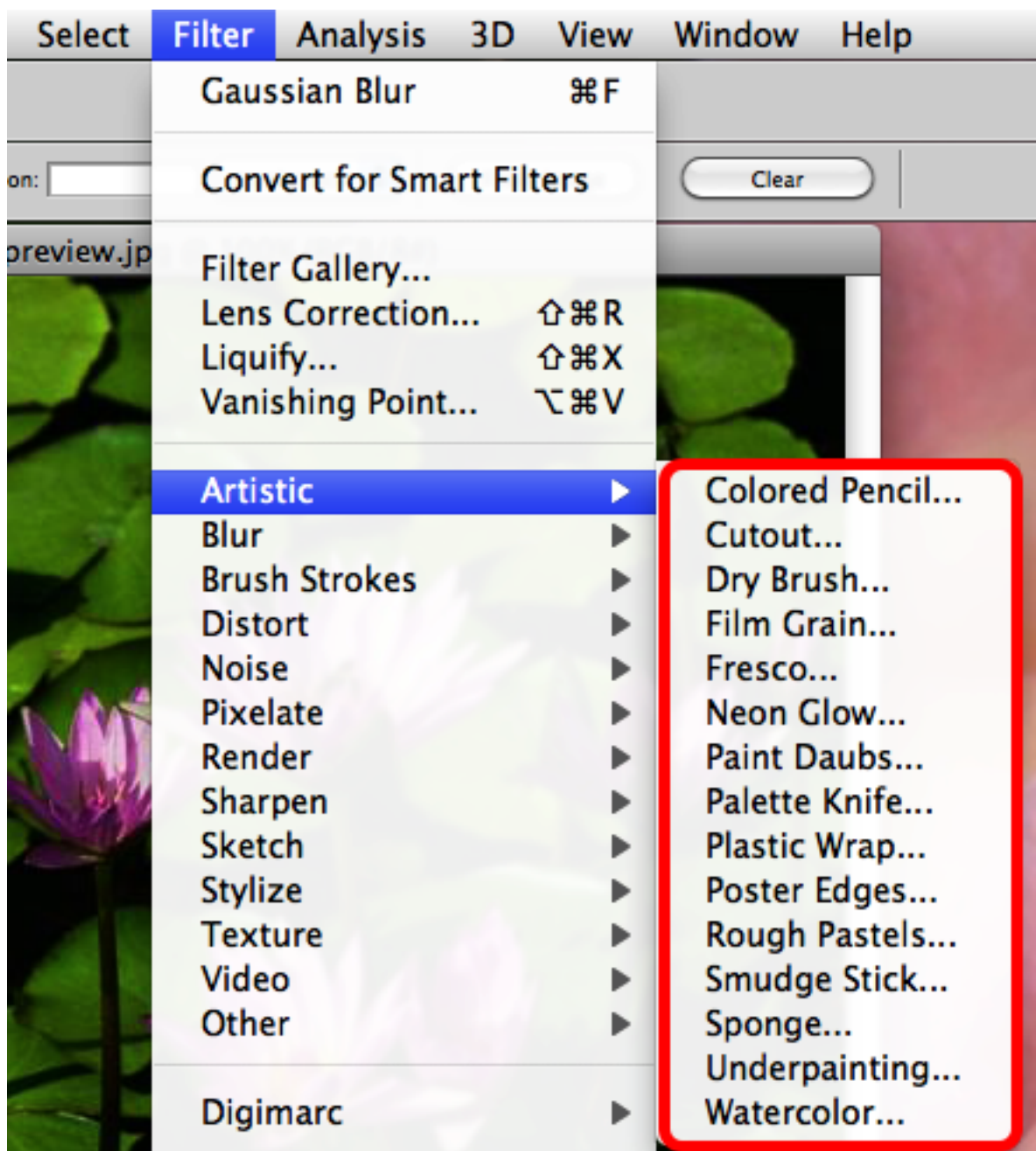

### Select "Filter"



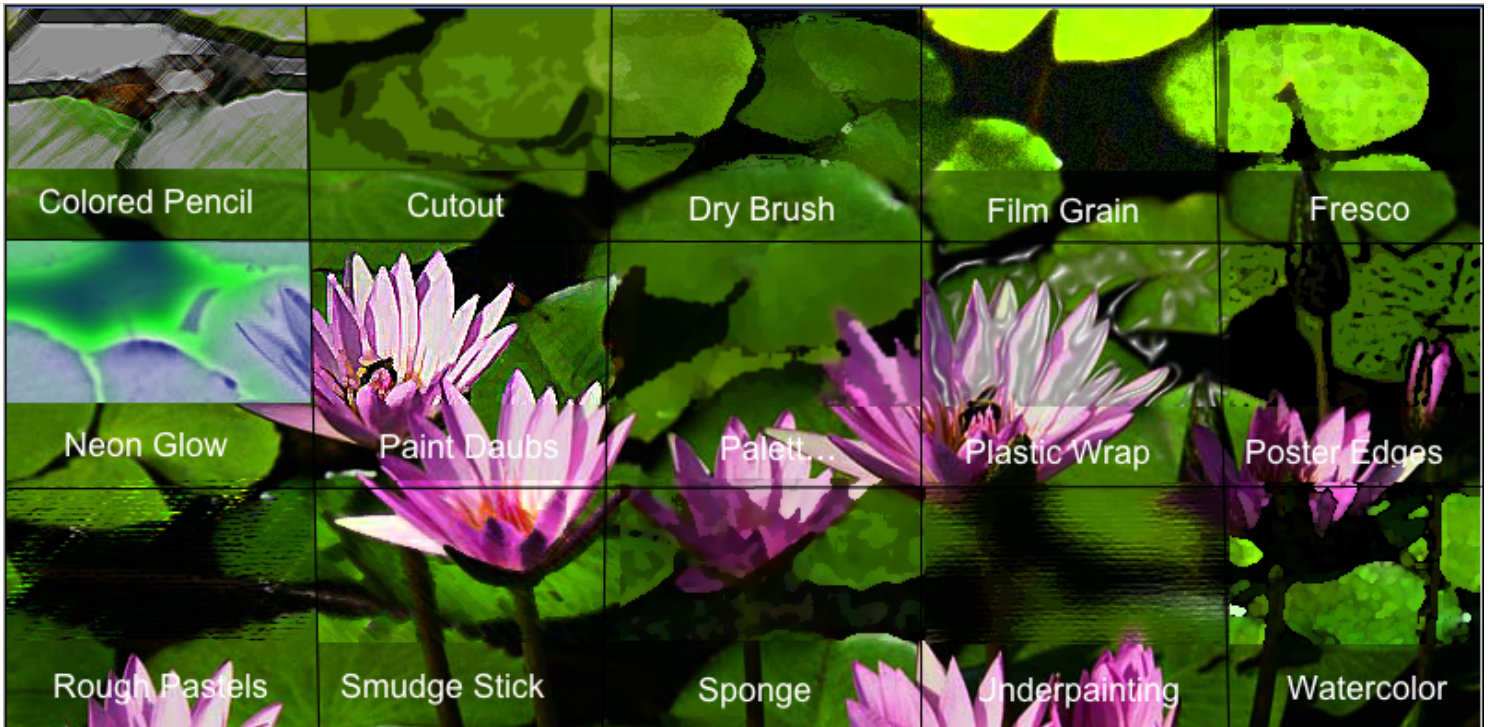
A drop down menu will show all of the different effects that you can apply to your image.

## Artistic Effects

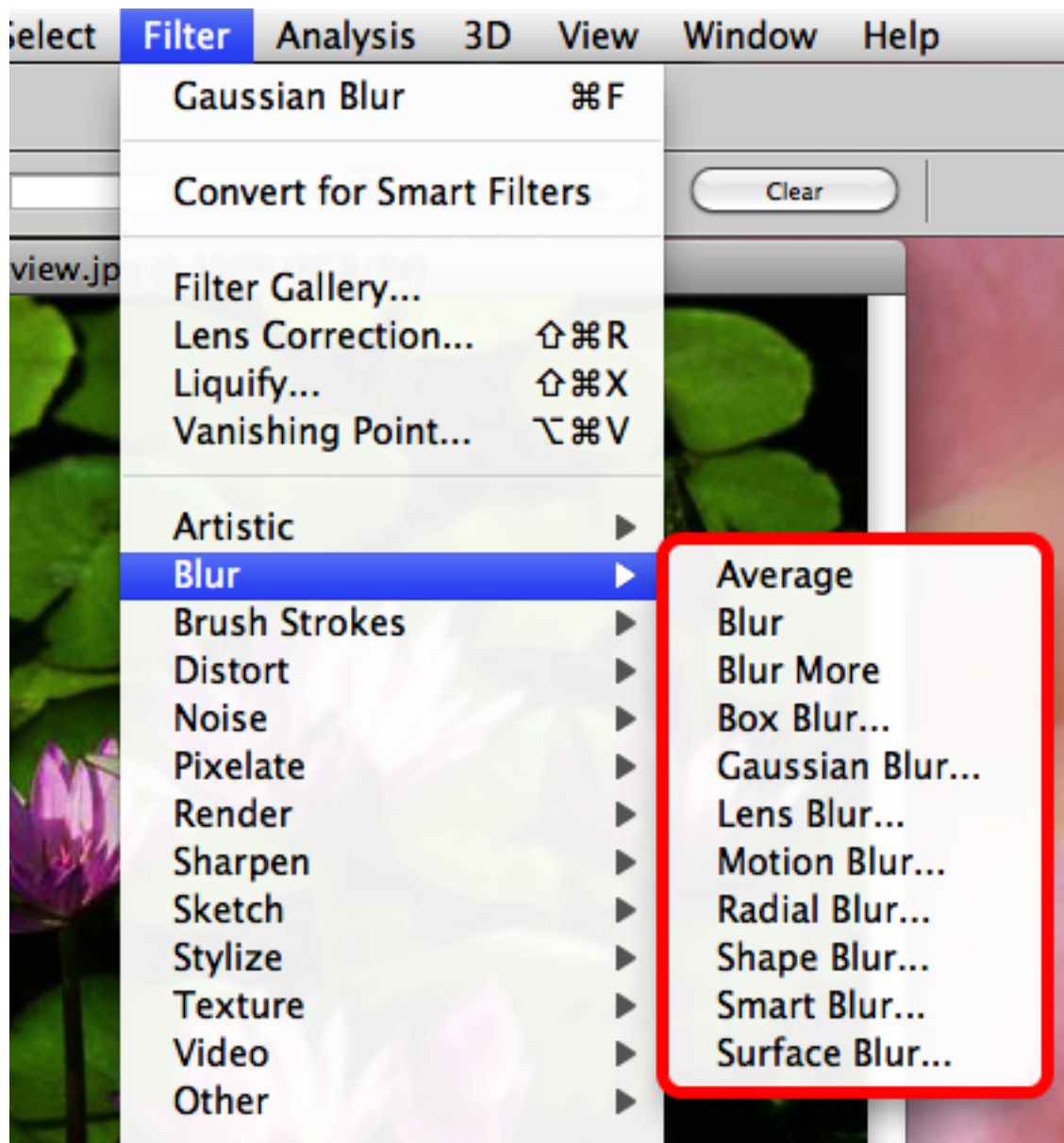


These effects will make your image look more artistic through the use of different paints or painting techniques.

## Blur Effects

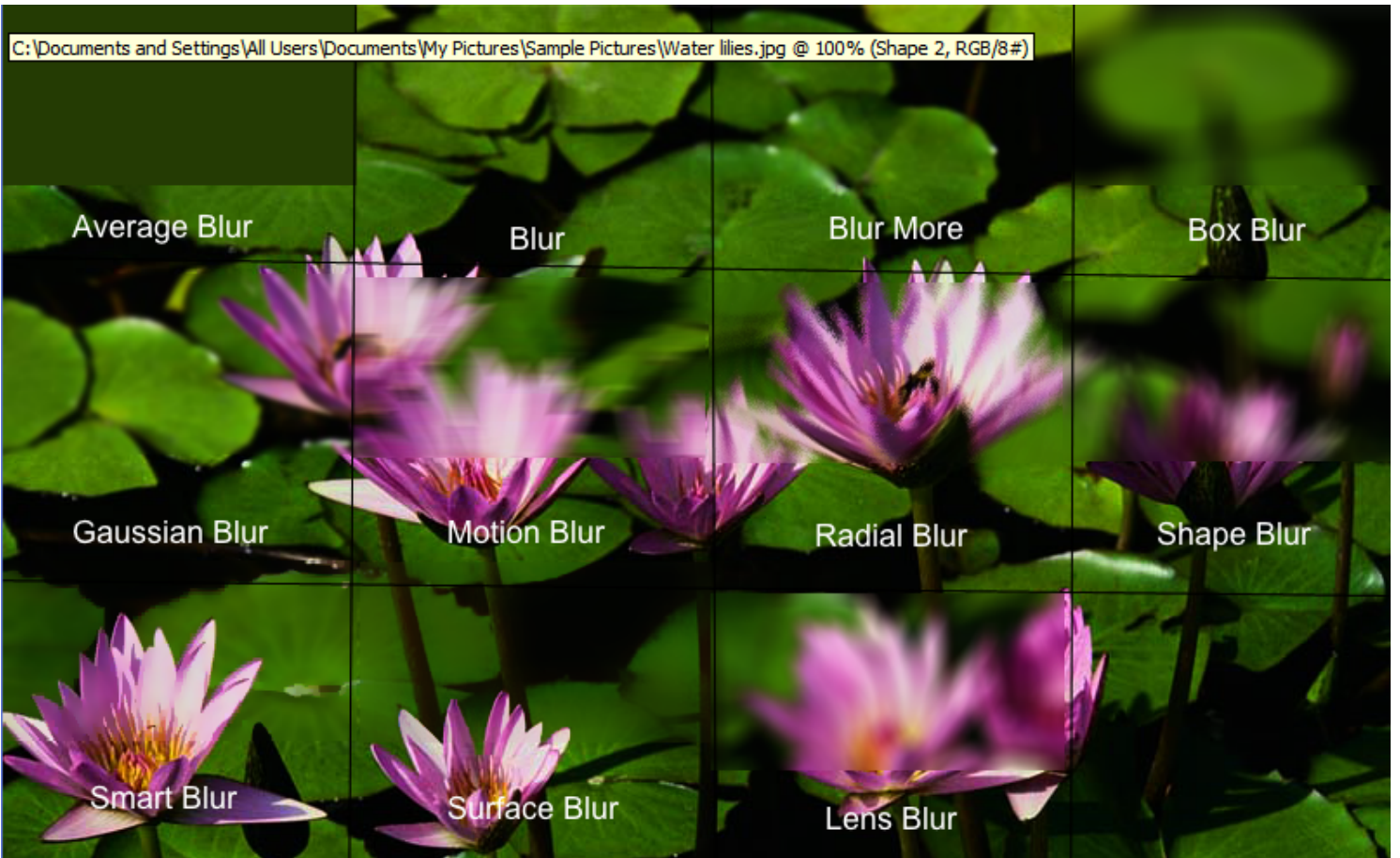


These effects create different types of blurs on your image.

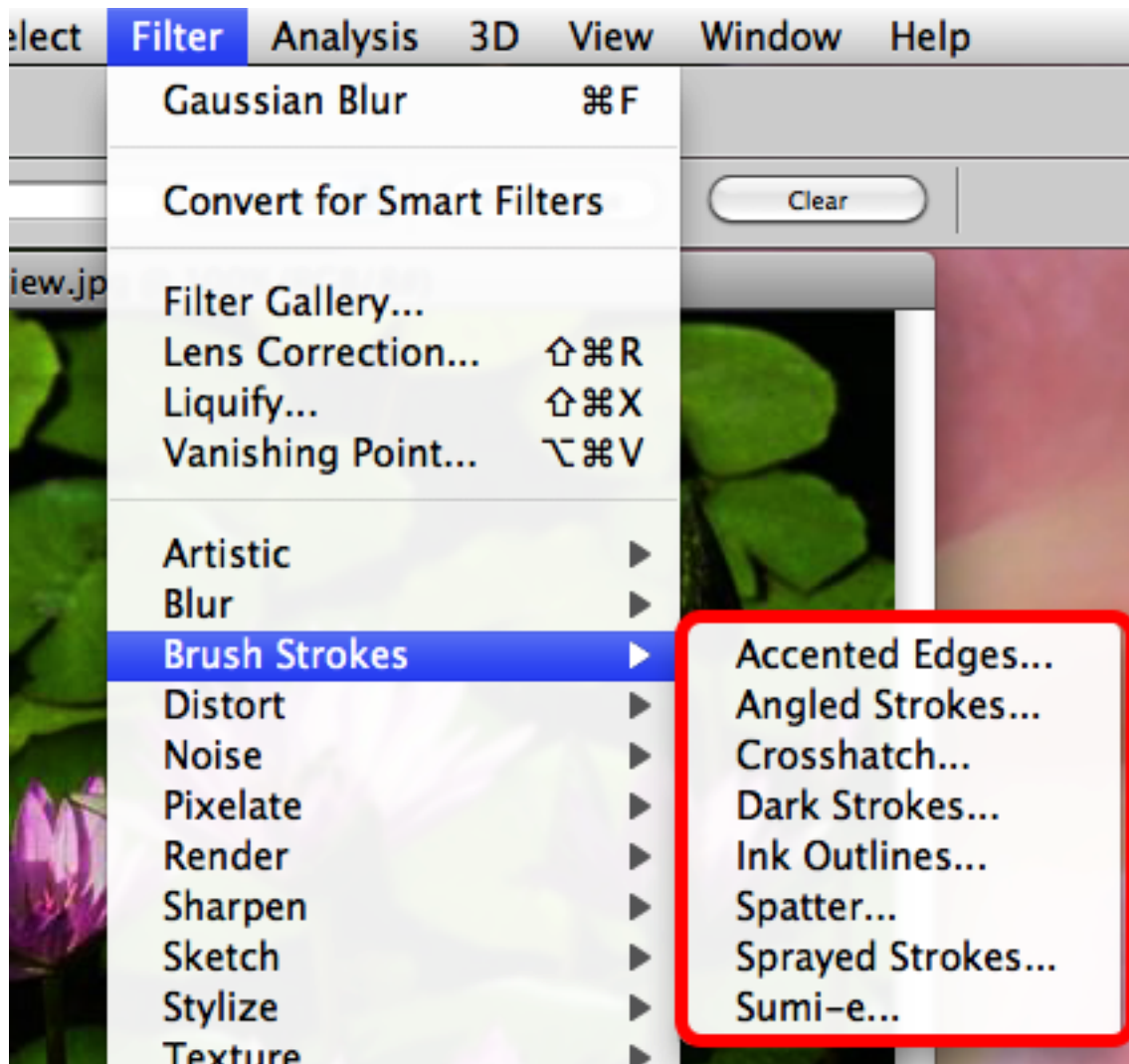
Most commonly used blur:

## Blur Effects Applied

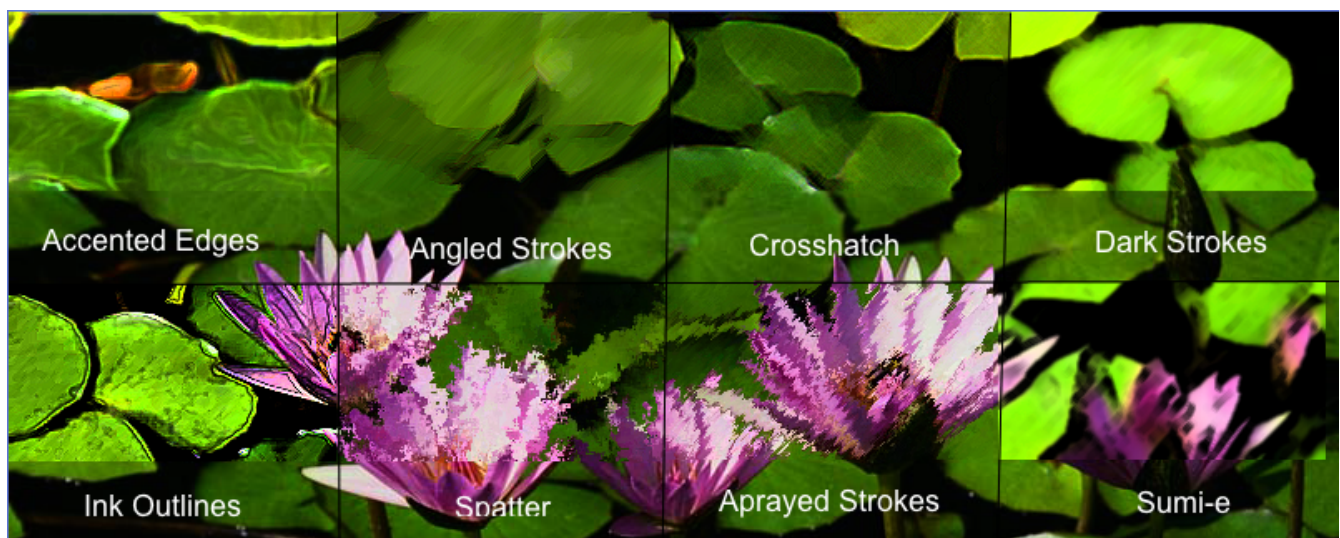


## Brush Stroke Effects

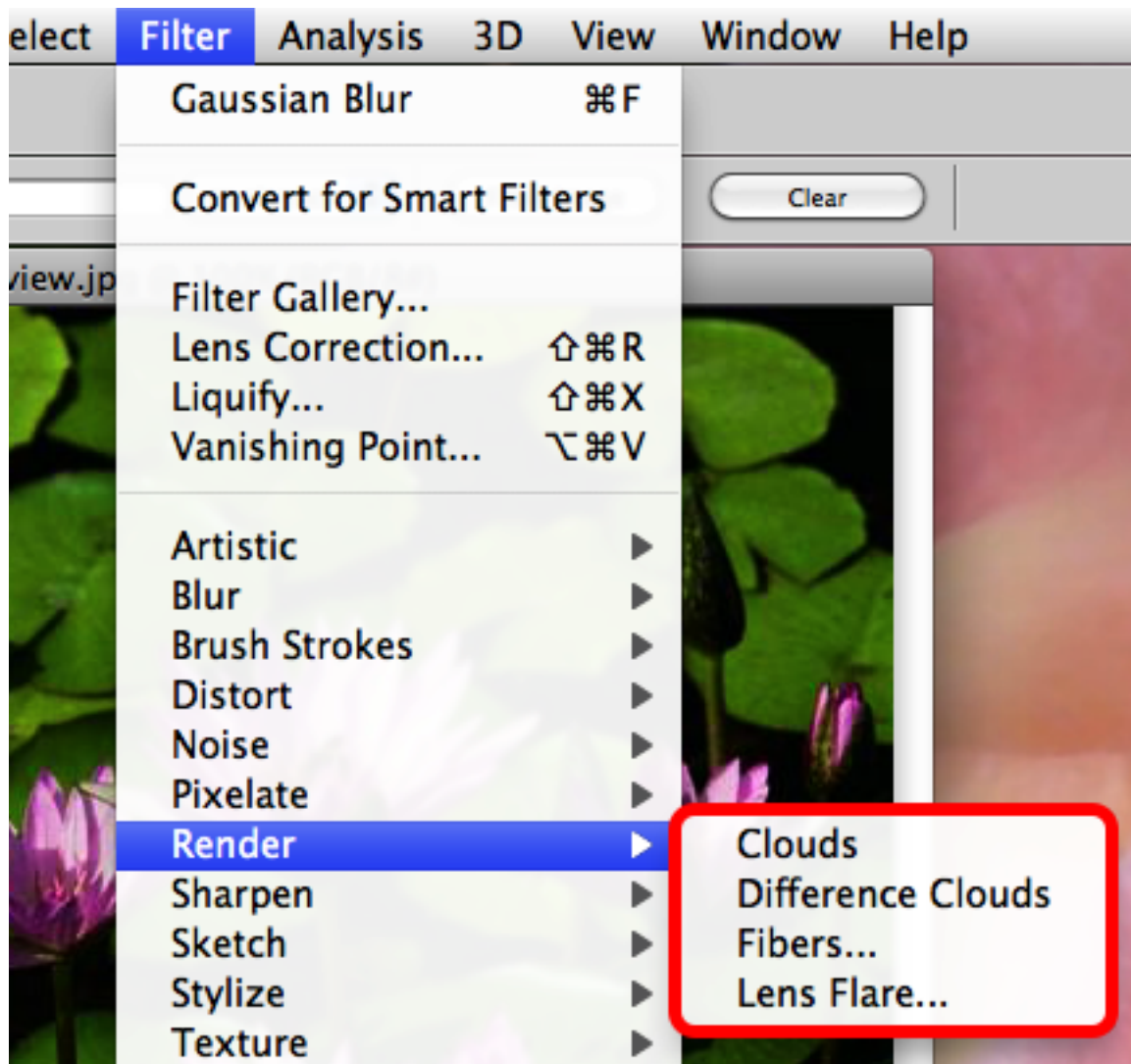


These effects create different artistic brush strokes across your image.

## Brush Stroke Effect Applied

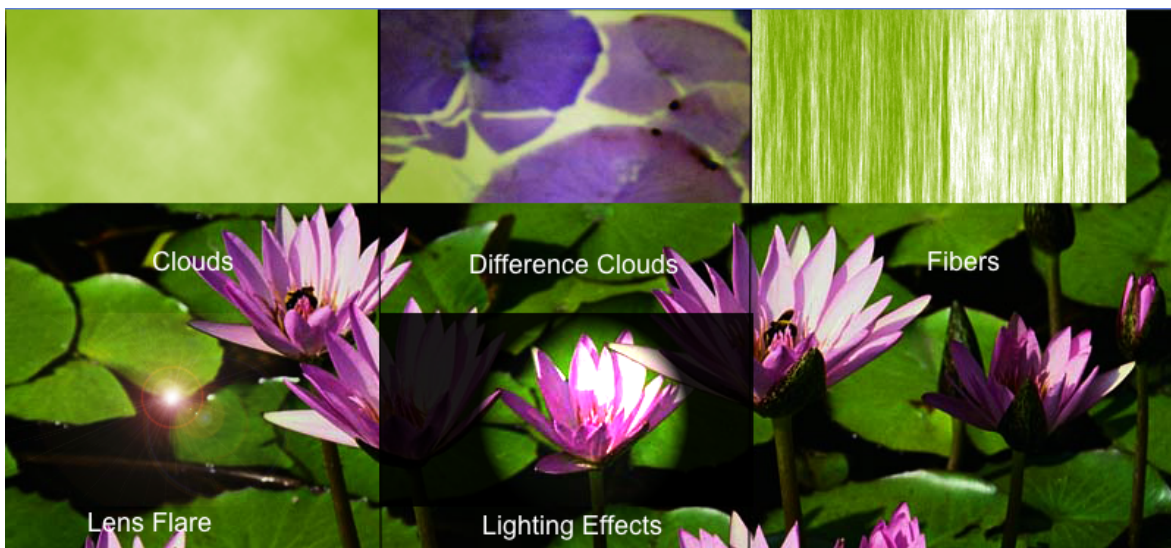


## Render Effects

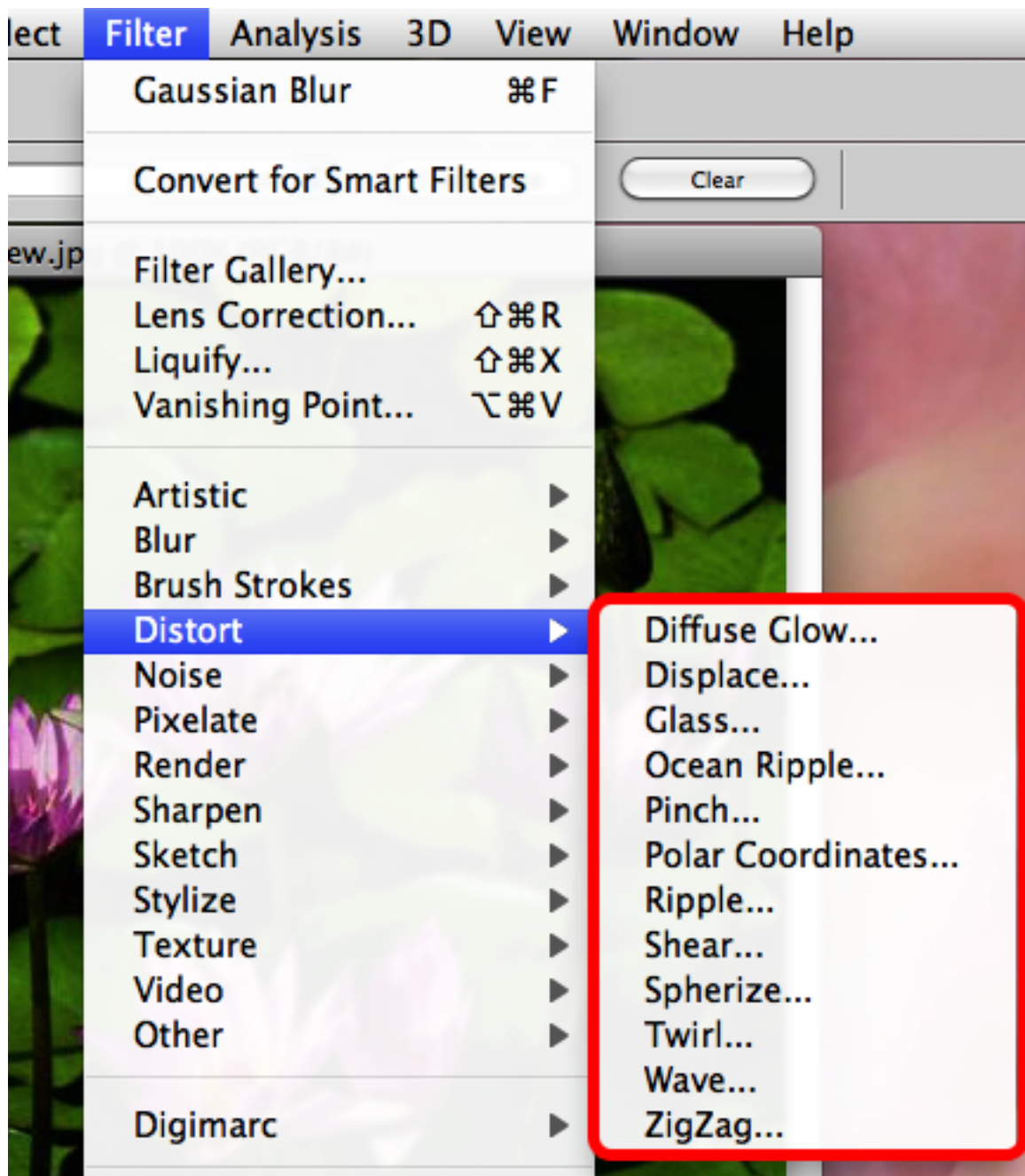


These tools will add lighting effects to your image.

## Render Effects Applied



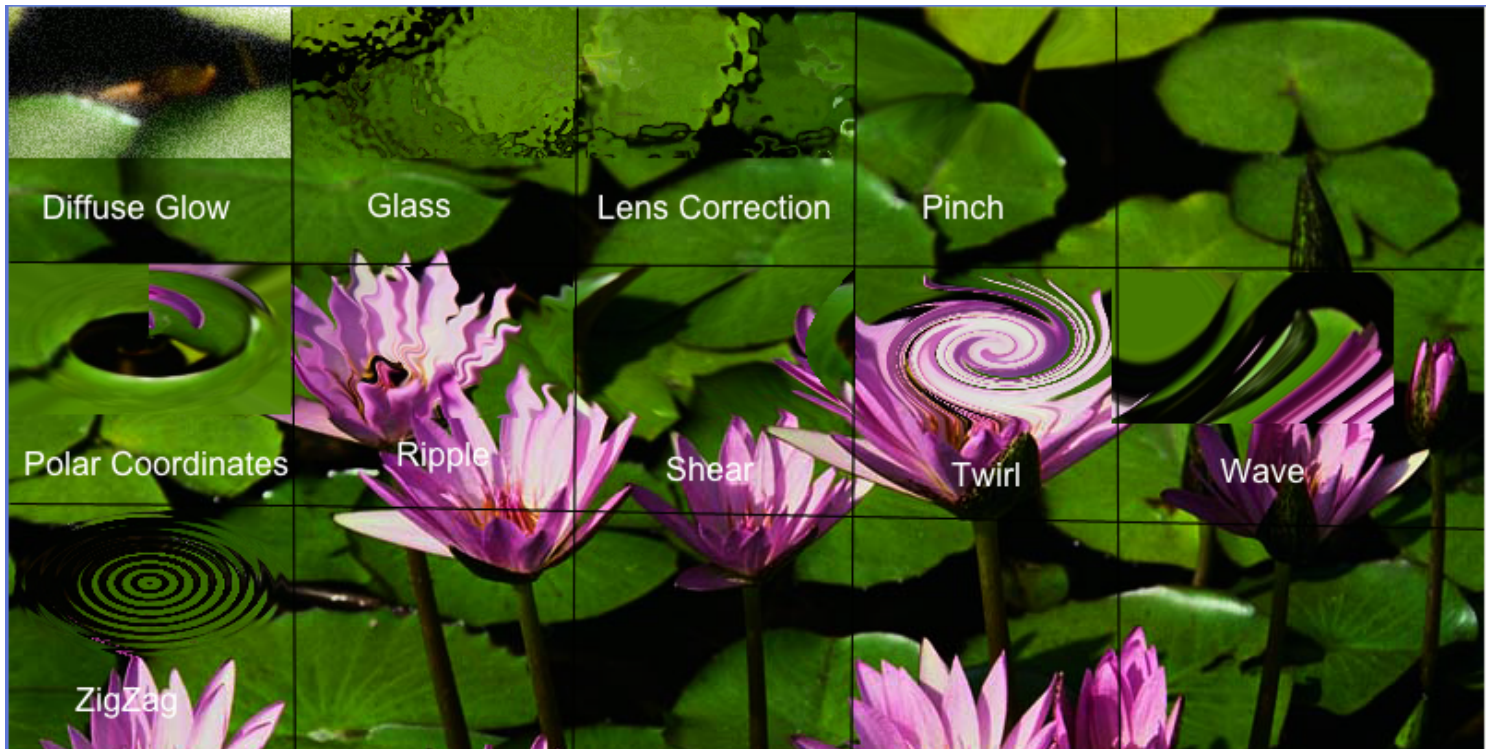
## Distort Effects



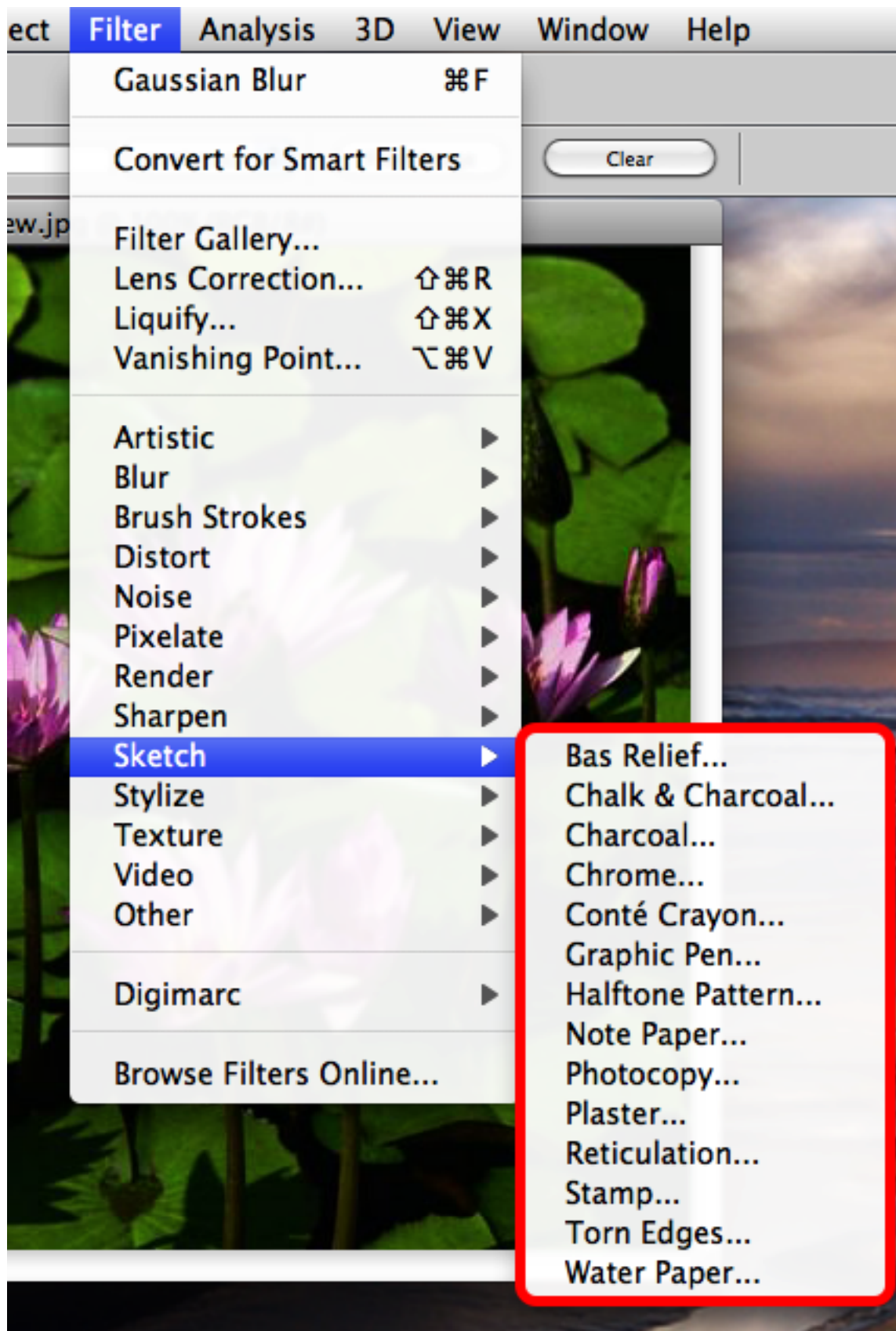
These effects will allow you to distort your image.



## Distort Effects Applied

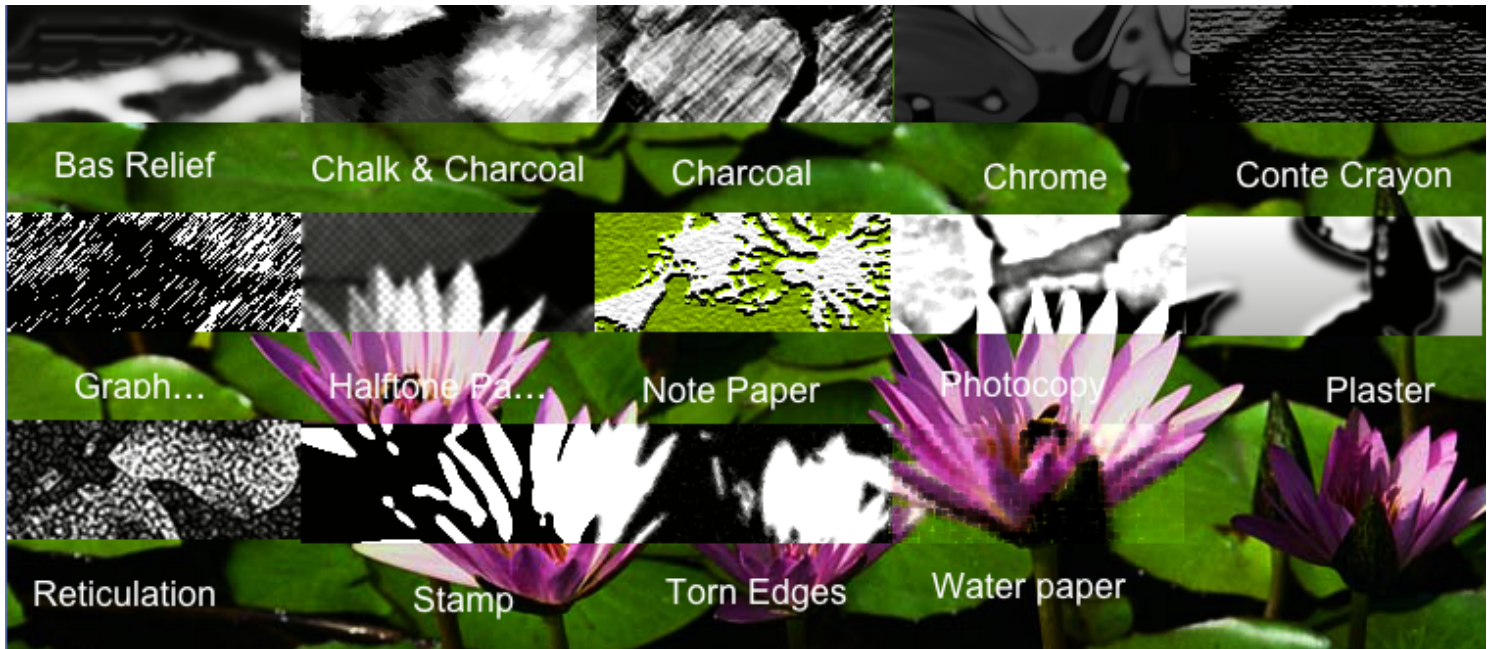


## Sketch Effects

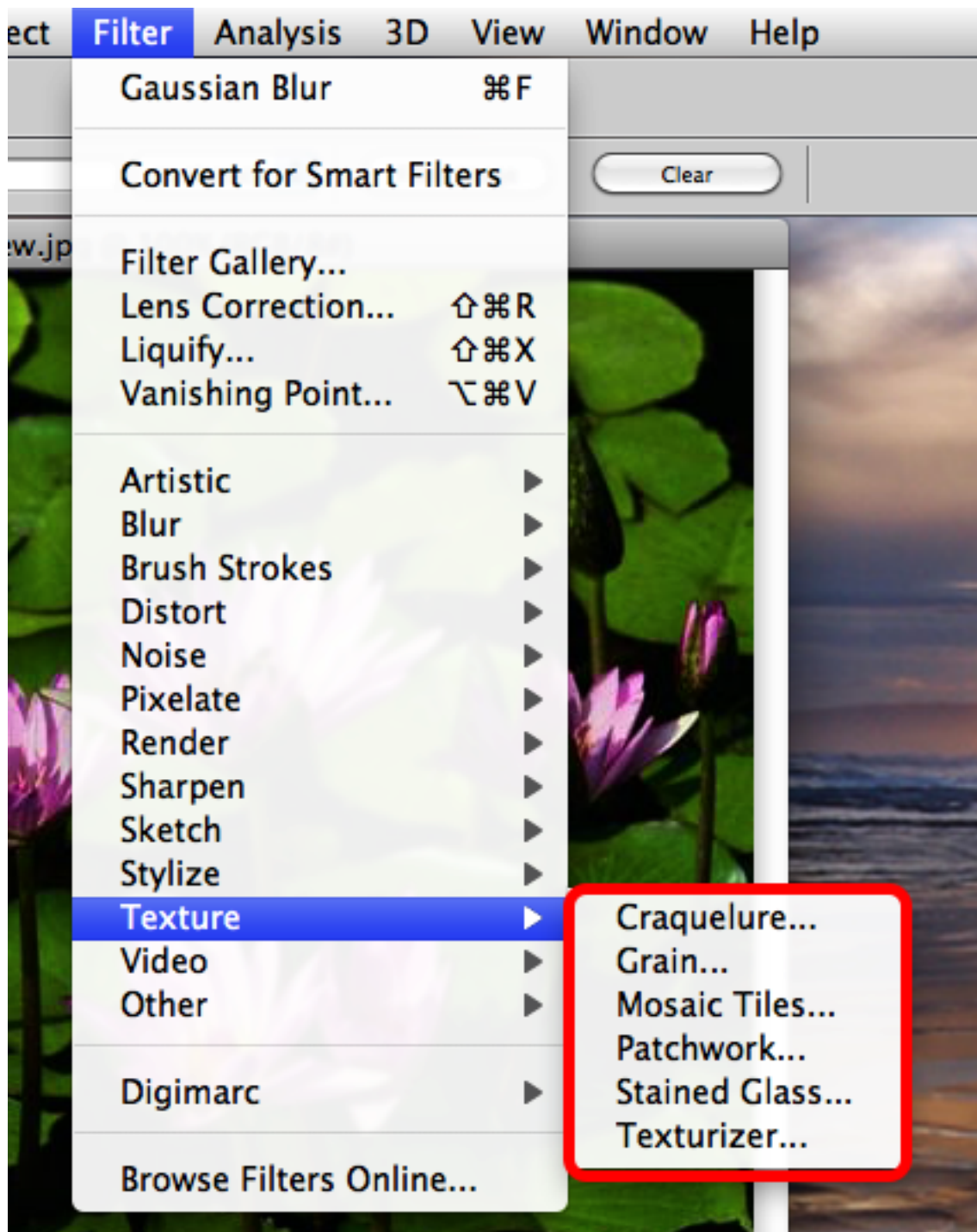


These effects will make your image look like it was sketched through the use of different sketching techniques.
